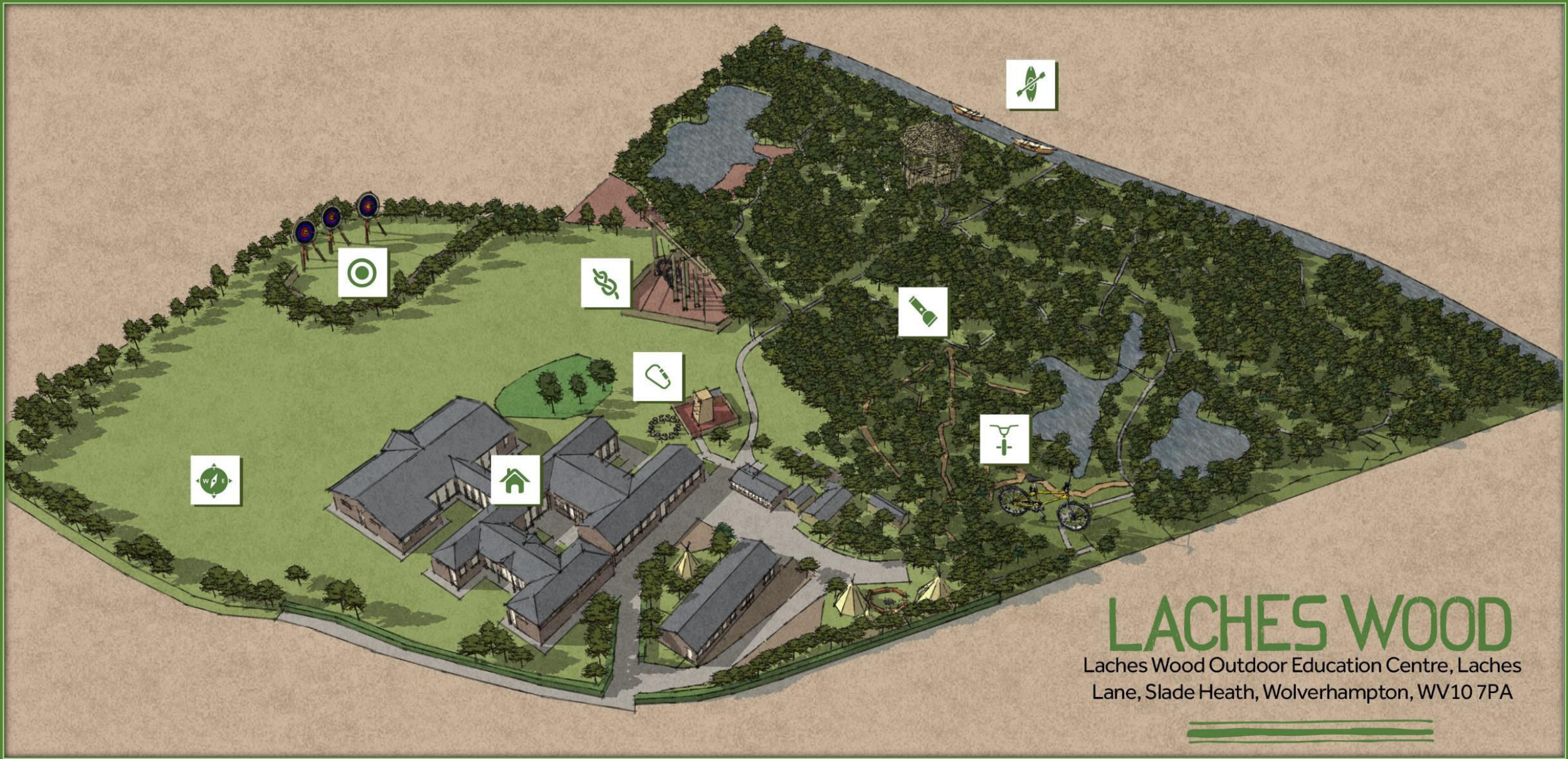

Sleeping

The children are required to make their own beds. Duvets and pillows are provided, but the children must have their own single duvet cover and one pillowcase.

All external doors are alarmed in the dormitories. Our wing will only have Westminster in them. Room sizes vary from rooms of 6 to 16.

Main doors require a key code to access.

Girls/boys will sleep separately, as well as having separate shower facilities.



Eating

Meal choices for our stay will be made when we get there.

Variety of hot and cold food available.

Taps for drinking water so the children can fill up their water bottle.

Spending

There is a small gift shop on site – children can order souvenirs to take home – magnets, key rings rulers etc.

Maximum £5 in a marked sandwich bag/envelope. Children can give this to staff on the morning of our trip to keep safe.
