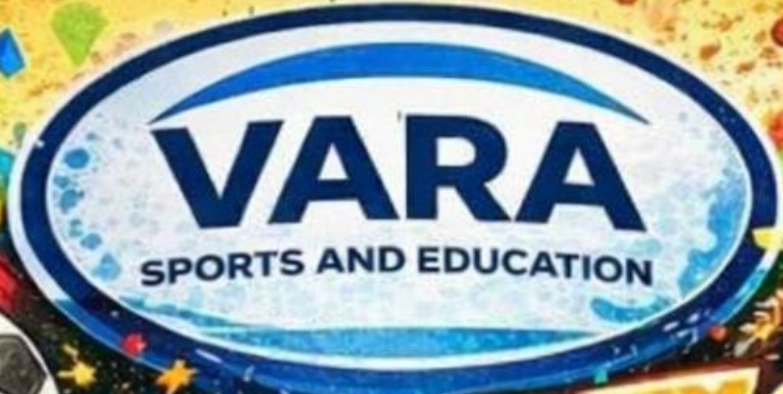

- ✓ The course aims to help parents to understand and support their child's wellbeing, reduce stress, distress and distress related behaviours

- ✓ The course takes place for 2.5 hours a week for 11 weeks
